(I) DEMAND NO. 4 - LAND REVENUE, STAMPS & REGISTRATION AND DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION :

Shri Y. Joykumar Singh, Deputy Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :

"that a sum not exceeding Rs. 187,65,07,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2022 in respect of Demand No. 4 - Land Revenue, Stamps & Registration and District Administration"

MOTION FOR DISAPPROVAL OF POLICY CUT :
