- (I) DEMAND NO. 15-CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION:  
Shri Y. Joykumar Singh, Deputy Chief Minister (in-charge of Finance) to move :-

*“that a sum not exceeding Rs.82,16,82,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2022 in respect of Demand No. 15- Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution”.*

### MOTION FOR DISAPPROVAL OF POLICY CUT:

S/Shri K. Ranjit Singh, Th. Lokeshwar Singh and Kh. Joykisan Singh, MLAs to move :-

*“that the amount of the demand be reduced to Re.1/-”*

### On account of :-

- (i) Inability to implement free and fair Public Distribution System timely (particularly in the climax time of the Covid-19 pandemic).
- (ii) Lack of proper policy to issue priority Ration Cards under NFSA to the beneficiaries.
- (iii) Inability to distribute food grains to the satisfaction of the beneficiaries.
