ACT

further to amend the Uttar Pradesh Municipalities, Notified Areas and Town  
Areas (Alpakalik Vyavastha) Adhiniyam, 1977, and the Uttar Pradesh  
Urban Local Self-Government Laws (Third Amendment) Act, 1978.

IT IS HEREBY enacted in the Thirty-Sixth Year of the Republic of India as  
follows :—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Uttar Pradesh Urban Local Self-  
Government Laws (Amendment) Act, 1985.

Short title and  
commencement.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on December 31, 1984.

2. In section 2 of the Uttar Pradesh Municipalities, Notified Areas and  
Town Areas (Alpakalik Vyavastha) Adhiniyam, 1977, hereinafter referred to  
as the principal Act, for the word and figures "December 31, 1984" wherever  
occurring, the word and figures "December 31, 1985", shall be substituted

3. In section 3 of the principal Act, for the word and figures "December  
31, 1984" the word and figures "December 31, 1985", shall be substituted.

4. In section 24 of the Uttar Pradesh Urban Local Self-Government Laws  
(Third Amendment) Act, 1978, for the word and figures "December 31, 1984",  
the word and figures "December 31, 1985", shall be substituted.

5. (1) The Uttar Pradesh Urban Local Self-Government Laws (Amend-  
ment) Ordinance, 1985, is hereby repealed.

Repeal and saving

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken  
under the Acts referred to in sections 2 and 4 as amended by the Ordinance  
referred to in sub-section (1), shall be deemed to have been done or taken under  
the corresponding provisions of the said Acts as amended by this Act as if  
the provisions of this Act were in force at all material times.
