Minutes of the virtual meeting held under the chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs, Government of India on Wednesday, 15th Feb, 2023 at 03:00 P.M. with Bihar Legislative Assembly.

The virtual meeting to review the progress status of National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) in Bihar Legislative Assembly was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs (MoPA), GOI on Wednesday the 15th Feb, 2023 at 03:00 P.M. The list of Participants is Annexed.

At the outset, the Secretary welcomed all the participants and enquired about the current status of the NeVA project in their state. The Secretary, Bihar Legislative Assembly briefed on the physical and financial progress of NeVA implementation in their state.

After discussions and deliberations, the following decisions were taken:-

- 1. The Secretary, Bihar Legislative Assembly stated that the Hon'ble Speaker, Bihar Assembly has been briefed about NeVA but the approval is awaited from him which had led to the delay in the implementation of the project.
- 2. Secretary, MoPA emphasised that since the 1st instalment of funds amounting to Rs. 1,91,64,012/- have been released long ago on 09th Dec. 2020, the parting of the central funds for too long would lead to financial irregularity. He also stated that the funds should be utilized within the stipulated time period as per the project guidelines. This matter should also be brought into the cognizance of authorities concerned for appropriate action.
- 3. The Secretary, MoPA made the following observations and recommendations after deliberations:-
 - The Utilization Certificate (UC) for the 1st instalment so released should be submitted at the earliest.
 - Proper guidance may be provided to the Assembly in the Hardware procurement process by NIC.
 - A meeting may be convened between Assembly/State govt. and the State NIC for working out
 the modalities for implementation of NeVA project covering all the financial, technical and
 security related aspects.
- 4. The Secretary, MoPA told that NIC and NICSI should review the progress status with regard to all the technical aspects and the procurement process on fortnightly basis and provide the report to CPMU.
- 5. The Secretary, MoPA informed the participants about the proposed National Workshop at the end of February / early March, 2023 for all the states to undertake review of the status of NeVA, discussion of the issues being confronted in its implementation in all the States and sharing of experience of the States that have already digitalised their Houses through NeVA. He requested for participation of Assembly/ State Govt.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
