### BUDGET SESSION MONDAY, MARCH 15<sup>TH</sup>, 2021

The House met at 10 a.m. with Hon'ble Speaker in the Chair and sat till 06:11 P.m.

The day was allotted for Government Business.

#### 1. Questions.

Question nos 65 to 69 were taken up and disposed off.

#### 2. Privilege Motion.

The Hon'ble Speaker informed the House that Shri Zenith M. Sangma, MLA, has given Notice of complaint to the Chief Minister under Rule 167 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business, informing that a motion of Privilege under Rule 158 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business will be raised by him on Monday, the 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2021. Shri Zenith M. Sangma, MLA, has also submitted a letter to the Commissioner & Secretary, Meghalaya Legislative Assembly at 09:00 a.m. informing that he would like to bring "a Motion of Breach of Privilege" to the notice of the August House under Rule 158 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business.

The Chief Minister informed that he has received the Notice. Shri Zenith M. Sangma, MLA, then read his complaint and made a short statement relating to the complaint of Breach of Privilege against the Chief Minister and also referring to the proceeding of the August House of 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2021.

Shri Conrad K. Sangma, Chief Minister replied.

Dr. Mukul M. Sangma, Leader of Opposition, also participated in the discussion.

Shri Zenith M. Sangma, MLA, did not withdraw the Motion of Breach of Privilege. The Motion was then put to vote to the House. It was rejected by voice vote.
