RESOLUTION TO REPEAL 'THE EMPLOYMENT OF MANUAL SCAVENGERS AND CONSTRUCTION OF DRY LATRINES (PROHIBITION), ACT, 1993'.

SHRI. NEIPHIU RIO, moved for the introduction, consideration and adoption of the following resolution:

"RESOLUTION

ON THE REPEAL OF 'THE EMPLOYMENT OF MANUAL SCAVENGERS & CONSTRUCTION OF DRY LATRINES (PROHIBITION), ACT, 1993'

Whereas, in the interest of the public, the State Government had adopted 'The Employment of Manual Scavengers & Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition), Act, 1993' in the year 2008. Whereas, the Act has become redundant with the enactment of the new Act i.e 'The Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act 2013'.

And whereas, since 'The Employment of Manual Scavengers & Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition), Act, 1993' was enacted by the Parliament under Article 252 of the Constitution and subsequently, adopted by various States, its repeal can be done only as per the procedure prescribed under Article 252 which require passing of resolution for the repeal of the 1993 Act by the State Legislature.

And whereas, the Cabinet has approved for repeal of the Act of 1993.

THIS HOUSE UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVES:

To repeal 'The Employment of Manual Scavengers & Construction of Dry Latrines (Prohibition), Act, 1993' so that the State Government may further take action for the adoption of the new Act i.e. 'The Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act 2013'."

The Resolution was unanimously adopted by the House.




