1. 11.14 AM The Chair welcomed all the Hon'ble Members to the Sixth Session of the Eighth Legislative Assembly. He expressed confidence that the Members would uphold democratic values, parliamentary traditions and the dignity of the House while participating in meaningful and constructive discussions on issues of public importance.
The Chair urged all the Hon'ble Members to extend their full cooperation for the smooth conduct of the proceedings and conveyed best wishes for a successful and productive session.
The Chair ruled that no business other than the business listed for the day will be taken up for discussion by the House.
2. 11.15 AM **Obituary References:**
The House paid homage to the following:
 1. The victims who lost their lives in the tragic fire incidents that occurred in Vivek Vihar on 03 May 2026, Malviya Nagar on 03 June 2026, and Dwarka on 31 July 2026.
 2. Dr. D. Y. Patil, former Governor of Bihar, West Bengal and Tripura, who passed away on 04 August 2026
 3. The victims who lost their lives in the powerful earthquake that struck Kumamoto Prefecture, Japan, on 28 July 2026.
 4. Sh. Baljor Singh, former Member of the Legislative Assembly of National Capital Territory of Delhi on 07 August 2026.The House observed two minutes silence as a mark of respect to the departed souls.
3. 11.22 AM **Congratulatory Motion (Rule-114) :**
The Chair congratulated the Indian contingent for its outstanding performance at the Commonwealth Games held in Glasgow, Scotland, where India secured 39 medals, including 13 Gold, 17 Silver and 9 Bronze medals, and achieved fourth place in the medal tally.
The House conveyed its heartfelt congratulations to the athletes, coaches and support staff, and expressed confidence that their remarkable achievements would continue to inspire the youth of the nation and bring further glory to the country.
4. 11.23 AM The Chair introduced Dr. Yumnam Arun Kumar, who had assumed charge as Secretary of the Delhi Legislative Assembly and extended a warm welcome to him on behalf of the House.
5. 11.24 AM The Chair informed the House that the Delhi Legislative Assembly has invited the Digital India BHASHINI Division to conduct a pilot trial of its AI-powered live transcription and translation system during Assembly proceedings to assess its effectiveness in enhancing legislative efficiency and accessibility. He informed that the system which was launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister Sh. Narendra Modi in July 2022 under the National Language Translation Mission, BHASHINI leverages Artificial Intelligence to provide multilingual transcription and translation services and this was the first-ever pilot deployment of the system in any legislative body in India.
The Chair further informed that the pilot trial will be evaluated based on system performance, transcription quality and user feedback before any decision on wider implementation.
