2. 12.27 PM **Censure Motion (Rule-114) :**

**Sh. Satish Upadhyay, Hon'ble Member** moved a Censure Motion in the House expressing deep concern and strongly condemning the remarks made by the senior leaders of Aam Aadmi Party during a press conference held on 24 March 2026, wherein the initiatives announced by the Delhi Government in the Budget (2026-27) for the empowerment of girls such as provision of bicycles, improved education and laptops were reportedly ridiculed. He stated that such remarks were disrespectful towards girls and reflected a narrow and anti-women mindset, undermining efforts towards women empowerment and sending a negative message to society. He further stated that the concerned individual should tender a public apology.
