*“The Legislative Assembly of NCT of Delhi in its sitting held on 28<sup>th</sup> April 2026 resolves that :*

*“Whereas the Parliament of India and the Government of India, under the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi, Hon’ble Prime Minister, brought the Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam, 2023 to ensure 33% reservation for women in the Parliament and State Legislatures including the Delhi Assembly;*

*Whereas, through the Constitution (131st Amendment) Bill, 2023, the Government of India desired to bring the benefits of the Women’s Reservation at the earliest;*

*Whereas the Opposition parties conspired and colluded to defeat this historic bill for their narrow political gains, thereby delaying the implementation of Women’s Reservation;*

*Now therefore, this House condemns the attempts by the Opposition Parties to defeat the laudable steps taken under the leadership of Shri Narendra Modi, Hon’ble Prime Minister of India for women empowerment through the Women’s Reservation; and*

*This House resolves that it wholeheartedly welcomes the initiatives for women empowerment including women’s reservation and expresses its strong support for the early implementation of the Nari Shakti Vandan Adhiniyam.”*
