GUJARAT BILL NO. 15 OF 2023.

A BILL

to authorize payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Gujarat for the services of the financial years ending on the thirty-first day of March 2008, thirty-first day of March 2014.

It is hereby enacted in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. This Act may be called the Gujarat Appropriation (Excess Short title. Expenditure) Act, 2023.
- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Gujarat, there shall be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 4 of Schedule I hereto annexed amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one thousand fifty-five crores, thirty-eight lakhs, twenty-six thousand rupees

towards defraying the several charges which have come in course of payment during the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March 2008, in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of Schedule I.

Issue of ₹ 3,47,05,36,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Gujarat for the financial year 2008-2009.

3. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Gujarat, there shall be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 4 of Schedule II hereto annexed amounting in the aggregate to the sum of three hundred forty-seven crores, five lakhs, thirty-six thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which have come in course of payment during the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March 2009, in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of Schedule II.

Issue of ₹ 10,26,34,76,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Gujarat for the financial year 2013-2014. 4. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Gujarat, there shall be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 4 of Schedule III hereto annexed amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one thousand twenty-six crores, thirty-four lakhs, seventy-six thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which have come in course of payment during the financial year ending on the thirty-first day of March 2014, in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of Schedule III.

Appropriation.

5. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Gujarat by this Act shall be deemed to have been appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in Schedule I, Schedule II and Schedule III in relation to the financial years ending on the thirty-first day of March 2008, thirty-first day of March 2009 and thirty-first day of March 2014, respectively.
