The Fact-Finding Committee of Haryana Vidhan Sabha which was actually entrusted with the task to investigate in the matter of sexual harassment by the then Principal (Mr. Kartar Singh) of Government Girls Senior Secondary School, Uchana Mandi (Jind) for the period from 2005 to 2023 of all incidents mentioned/discussed in the House in its sittings dated 15th and 18th December, 2023. In the matter, the report of the Committee was substantially required to be submitted in the first meeting of the next Session of Haryana Vidhan Sabha i.e. February, Session, 2024. Since the matter is highly sensitive. Therefore, the Committee was of the view that it would no appropriate to submit the report on the matter under review without detailed examination. However, this issue is under active consideration of the Committee. Resultantly, the Committee sought time upto first sitting of the next Session of Haryana Vidhan Sabha i.e. Current Session commencing from today, 13th March, 2024 to submit its report by moving a motion in the House on 20th February, 2024. The Committee further recommends that the time for submission of report may please be extended upto first sitting of the next Session of Haryana Vidhan Sabha.
