Respected Sir,

This notice is for calling attention of this August House/Government to the harassment caused to the common citizen on account of defective, deficient survey of property ID's in Haryana town and cities done recently by a private firm. Work order to conduct the survey of property ID's, licences and house tax bills of all 89 municipalities of Haryana had been allotted to a single private firm by the state Government/ Urban Local bodies departments on 04-10-2018 for an amount of 21 Crores. The work was to be completed by the year up-to 2022. Though the firm did not complete the survey work satisfactorily the firm was made a payment of Rs.57 Crores, leaving about 42 Lacs urban properties of the state in the lurch.

This private firm had been allotted work ignoring government agencies like NIC, HARSAC and HARTRON. In the survey work, there are errors with respect to ownership, tenancy, area, plot no., built up area and zoning regulations (Commercial/residential) of urban properties. Rectification of errors is uphill task in view of a centralised data-server at Chandigarh. This has stalled the recovery of the municipal dues causing the loss to the exchequer and put our citizens in a quandary. My concern on this issue was brushed aside by the Minister concerned in the previous session of this August House.

This is matter of utmost public import, the same may be taken up for discussion, and the Minister concerned may be asked to make a statement on the floor of house as per procedure.
