He also remained the Leader of the Opposition in Punjab Legislative Assembly thrice in 1972, 1980 and 2002.

He was honoured with Padma Vibhushan, India's second highest civilian award in the year 2015 for his extremely valuable services. He was an eminent politician. He made important contribution in the development of the country and Punjab. He always endeavoured for the benefit of farmers. Our nation shall always remember his distinguished services with gratitude. In his long and illustrious career, he left an indelible imprint as a diplomat and statesman.
