The department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Haryana is providing healthcare, diagnostic, breeding and extension services to 71 lakhs animals of the State through a well-knit network of 2864 Government Veterinary Institutions, comprising 1815 Government Veterinary Dispensaries, 1042 Government Veterinary Hospitals, 6 Government Veterinary Polyclinics, 1 Pet Medical Centre and 21 Mobile Veterinary Units in the State. All kind of veterinary services including veterinary medicines are being provided to the livestock farmers by these institutions are totally free of costs.

c) The Rate Contract for Ayurvedic and Allopathic **Veterinary Medicines** issued by Director General, Supply and Disposal Department, Haryana, Panchkula was effective upto 27.05.2021 and 01.07.2022.

As per intimation from the Director General, Supplies & Disposals, Haryana (DGS&D), Panchkula vide their letter No. 2940 dated 07.07.2020 along with proceedings, the copy of which is also endorsed to state Govt., the observations of Hon'ble Chief Minister-Cum-Chairman of High Powered Purchase Committee (HPPC) during its meeting held on 28.05.2020 regarding arranging the Rate Contact for the purchase of Generic Allopathic Veterinary Medicine two-years rate contract basis in para no.07 is re-produced as under:

"In the meeting it was observed that since purchase relating to medical supplies are taken up by Haryana Medical Services Corporation Ltd. (HMSCL), similar requirements for medical supplies for Animal Husbandry can be taken up by the Special High Powered Purchase Committee

constituted for processing HMSCL purchase cases. The Administrative Secretary of Animal Husbandry can be co-opted as member for the purchase cases of Animal Husbandry Department. The DS&D was requested to tie up with Health Department for further action."

In the compliance of the above the department has series of conversation with Govt./HMSCL as at **Annexure-I**.

Keeping in the view of the availability of the Veterinary Medicines in the field level Animal Husbandry Institutions, the department has ordered the below tabulated (**Table-A**) Veterinary Medicines through GeM portal for distribution in field Animal Husbandry Institutions as per their demand for the year 2023-24 to fulfill the requirement of medicines as a stop gap arrangement till rate contract for veterinary medicines is being issued by the competent authority.

In addition to this, Budget to the tune of Rupees 3.01 crores has already been disbursed to the to the Deputy Directors of all districts vide Directorate's letter nos. 20174-95 PC dated 08.06.2023, 24756-77 dated 26.07.2023, 38480-38501 dated 13.12.2023 and 0857 PC dated 05.01.2024 for local purchase of Veterinary Medicines at their own level to meet-out the emergency requirement of medicines for field Animal Husbandry Institutions (**Table-B**) and budget utilization report for purchase of medicines at Deputy Director level is attached at **Table-C**.

It is pertinent to mention here that, after approval of Hon'ble Chief Minister of Haryana, this department has sent the indent to Directorate of Supplies and Disposal for procurement of 24 Allopathic Veterinary Medicines and 14 Ayurvedic Veterinary Medicines. The Directorate of Supplies and Disposal (DS&D) has issued tenders for procurement of Veterinary Medicines (Allopathic and Ayurvedic) on dated 03.01.2024 which has been opened on 01.02.2024. Technical evaluation of the bids by the technical committee of the department has been completed on 09.02.2024 and accordingly technical evaluation report has also been submitted to DS&D, Haryana for further process.

महानिदेशक, आपूर्ति एवं निपटान, हरियाणा (डी.जी.,एस.एंड.डी.), पंचकुला के पत्र संख्या 2940 दिनांक 07.07.2020 जिसकी प्रति राज्य सरकार को भी भेजी गई है, अनुसार जेनेरिक एलोपैथिक पशु चिकित्सा दवाइयों की खरीद के लिए उच्च स्तरीय क्रय समिति की 28.05.2020 को हुई बैठक के दौरान पैरा संख्या 07 में माननीय मुख्यमंत्री-सह-चेयरमैन महोदय के अवलोकन अनुसार प्रतिलिपि प्रस्तुत है -
