b) the number of the candidates who got employment through abovesaid letters togetherwith the details of those whose joining is still pending alongwith the reasons thereof; and

c) the time by which the joining is likely to be made as mentioned in part 'b' above?

Answer: SH. MANOHAR LAL, CHIEF MINISTER

- a) Sir, 1184 deployment offer letters DOL were issued by the Government through the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited from April 2023 to May 2023.
- b) Sir, the number of the candidates who were offered employment is 1184 and the candidates that joined are 697. The reasons for not joining are as follows:

There are no pending cases as the joining offer is closed after 15 days.

c). As stated in Answer to Point (b) above , out of the 1184 candidates who were offered employment, only 679 joined, leaving 487 candidates who did not join .The joining offer closes automatically after 15 days. Therefore, if the candidate does not join within that period, the offer is closed for them. However, the candidate goes back into the common pool after a cooling off period of one month. The candidate can be selected again for a suitable post if they figure in the merit list

generated as per the scoring criteria outlined in the Deployment of Contractual Personnel policy. However, the time period for reselection depends on the next suitable opening for the candidates and their scores in the merit list.
