## To Construct the Roads

whether it is a fact that all the following 6 karam roads in Palwal Assembly Constituency are unmetalled:-

- i) Lalgarh to Tikri Gujar;
- ii) Rahimpur to Rahimpur Nangla;
- iii) Kakrali to Lalwa;
- iv) Tappa to Peeragarhi;
- v) Sihol to Chandhat via Village Ghori; and
- b) if so, the time by which the construction work of said roads is likely to be started togetherwith the details thereof?

## DUSHYANT CHAUTALA, DEPUTY CHIEF MINISTER, HARYANA

- a) Sir, the road wise details are as under:
  - Lalgarh to Tikri Gujar: This is a Kacha path having effective consolidation path of less than 6 Karam and its length is 1.5 km. At present, there is no proposal for construction of said new road.
  - Rahimpur to Rahimpur Nangla:
    This is a Kacha path having effective consolidation path of 6 Karam and its length is 2.2 km. At present, there is no proposal for construction of said new road.
  - Kakrali to Lalwa:
    There already exists a mettaled road with a length of 1.9 km having 3.66 m wide carriageway. This road has been transferred from HSAMB. No other 6 Karam Kacha Path exists from Kakrali to Lalwa.
  - iv) Tappa to Peeragarhi:
    This is a Kacha path having effective consolidation path of 6 Karam and its length is 0.75 km. At present, there is no proposal for construction of said new road.
  - Sihol to Chandhat via Village Ghori:

    This is a Kacha path having effective consolidation path of less than 6 Karam and its length is 2.6 km. At present, there is no proposal for construction of said new
