- a) The reliable and authentic data source on Employment in the Country and all States/UTs is the Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS) which is conducted by National Sample Survey Organisation (NSSO) under the Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MOSPI), Government of India. According to the Annual PLFS Report for 2021-22 the latest year for which the report is available Unemployment Rate in Haryana is 9.3%. The figures of unemployment reported for Haryana are as follows:-
