2. CALLING ATTENTION NOTICES REGARDING THE MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE

- 1) **Mr. Abdul Majeed Bhat (Larmi)** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, (Minister Incharge Public Works)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to lack of connectivity from Kulgam-Qazigund Road to Chaki Badwani due to which people are facing significant inconveniences;
- 2) **Mr. Ajaz Ahmed Jan** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation & Reconstruction)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to recent flash floods and landslides in Poonch, Rajouri, Pirpanchal causing loss of precious lives and extensive damage to houses, roads and public property as such needs immediate attention of the Government for relief and restoration of connectivity;
- 3) **Mr. Sheikh Ahsan (Pardesi)** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, (Minister Incharge Mining)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen owing to recent directions/orders of the Mining Department vide No. GM/MNG/217/2025-04 dated:09.09.2026 requiring environmental clearance for the lifting/removal of loose material, which has resulted in serious difficulties for persons dealing with stone quarries and allied activities;
- 4) **Mr. Javaid Riyaz (Bedar)** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister, Incharge Jal Shakti** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to scarcity of portable drinking water in Village Alambal, Mirgund area of Pattan Constituency;
- 5) **Dr. Bharat Bhushan** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, (Minister Incharge Public Works)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to encroachment of Nallah on Jail Road Kathua by Jail authorities that has resulted in obstruction of free flow of Nallah resulting damage of the

road and inconvenience to the commuters, besides affecting health of the residents there.

- 6) **Justice(Rtd) Hasnain Masoodi** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister, (Minister Incharge Industries and Commerce)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to continuous use of Pet.Coke by the cement factories in Khrew-Khanmoh area which is producing deadly pollution in the area and posing grave threat to human and animal life ;

3. *BILLS FOR CONSIDERATION AND PASSING

- 1) **Mr. Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Housing and Urban Development)** to move that:-

"A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Municipal Act, 2000." (L.A. Bill No.10 of 2026) **be taken into consideration.**

Also to move that the Bill be passed.

- 2) **Mr. Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs),**to move that:-

"A Bill to consolidate and amend the law to replace permission-based control with rule-based governance and to enable citizens and enterprises to plan, invest, and work with confidence, and to foster Ease of Doing Business and Ease of Living in a manner that generates employment, attracts investment, and sustains long-term economic growth in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto." (L.A. Bill No. 11 of 2026) **be taken into consideration.**

Also to move that the Bill be passed.

- 3) **Mr. Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Finance),** to move that:-

"A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017" (L.A. Bill No. 12 of 2026) **be taken into consideration.**

Also to move that the Bill be passed.

- 4) **Mr. Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs),** to move that:-



"A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Ministers' and Ministers of State Salaries Act, 1956 (L.A. Bill No. 13 of 2026) **be taken into consideration.**

Also to move that the Bill be passed.

- 5) **Mr. Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs),** to move that:-

"A Bill to amend the Salaries and Allowances of Members of the Jammu and Kashmir State Legislature Act, 1960, and for matters connected or incidental thereto." (L.A. Bill No. 14 of 2026) **be taken into consideration.**

Also to move that the Bill be passed.

- 6) **Mr. Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs),** to move that:-

"A Bill to amend the Jammu and Kashmir State Legislature Members' Pension Act, 1984 and for matters connected or incidental thereto." (L.A. Bill No. 15 of 2026) **be taken into consideration.**

Also to move that the Bill be passed.

- 7) **Mr. Omar Abdullah, Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs),** to move that:-

"A Bill to amend certain enactments for decriminalising and rationalising offences for ease of living and ease of doing business and to repeal certain enactments and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto." (L.A. Bill No. 16 of 2026) **be taken into consideration.**

Also to move that the Bill be passed.
