**2. CALLING ATTENTION NOTICES REGARDING THE MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE**

- 1) **Mr. Arjun Singh Raju** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister, Incharge Jal Shakti** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to shortage of drinking water in Batote and Ramban Towns owing to non-functioning of filtration plants at Batote and Ward.No.02 of Ramban, besides, the shortage of water tankers in Ramban;
- 2) **Mr. Sajad Shaheen** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister, Incharge Jal Shakti** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to acute scarcity of drinking water in Banihal Constituency particularly in Sumar, Thachi, Manjit, Chajloo, Ramsoo, Tajnihal, besides several other habitations thereby causing severe hardships to the residents there;
- 3) **Mr. Sajad Gani Lone** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Chief Minister, (Minister Incharge Revenue)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to discrimination with Kashmir Division in issuance of certificates under the economically Weaker Sections(EWS) category due to Official apathy;
- 4) **Dr. Shafi Ahmad Wani** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Disaster Management, Relief, Rehabilitation & Reconstruction)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to recent flash floods in Beerwah Constituency, and the steps taken by the Government for affected persons and damage assessment including disbursement of compensation;
- 5) **Mr. Showkat Hussain Ganie** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister, Incharge Agriculture Production** towards a matter of

urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to premature fruit fall in orchards of Zainapora which has caused immense damage to the fruit growers;

- 6) **Mr. Altaf Ahmad Wani** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister, Incharge Jal Shakti** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to non-availability of drinking water facility at Wallarham, H. Kathal and Sofipora In Pahalgam Constituency;
- 7) **Mr. Shiekh Khursheed Ahmad** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister Incharge Forest, Ecology & Environment** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to undue delay in providing of permissible timber assistance to fire affected families of Neelipora, Lokipora, supernaghama, Tantarygund and Gundkuhroo villages of Langate Constituency;
- 8) **Shri Darshan Kumar** to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister Incharge Jal Shakti** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to failure in providing adequate funds for:(i) immediate restoration of damaged and suspended drinking water supply schemes in Panchayats Sandhar, Ghagrore, Palakha, Chummera, Manhanpur, Athoon and other areas of Dhar Mahanpur block damaged in recent floods;(ii) restoration of damaged irrigation Khuls at Kua, Noweshra, Nanilli, Severa, Gadodi and Draman;
