2. CALLING ATTENTION TO MATTERS OF URGENT PUBLIC IMPORTANCE

- 1) **MR. JAVID HASSAN BAIG**, to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister Incharge Health and Medical Education** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to alarming non-functionality of Ventilators at Government Medical College, Baramulla and serious lapses in critical care preparedness thereby endangering the lives of patients there.
- 2) **MR. IRSHAD RASOOL KAR**, to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister Incharge Jal Shakti** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to acute shortage of functional water tankers in Sopore Constituency, which has caused severe water scarcity there.
- 3) **MR. WAHEED UR REHMAN PARA**, to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Minister Health and Medical Education** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to rising incidence of cancer by the use of spurious and sub-standard pesticides in Jammu and Kashmir, particularly in major agricultural and horticultural areas.
- 4) **SHRI BALWANT SINGH MANKOTIA**, to call the attention of the **Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister (Minister Incharge Public Works)** towards a matter of urgent public importance viz; the situation that has arisen due to closure of roads from Nagulta-Razar and Gujad Chirdi to Thenidhar by landslides and non-

maintenance, which has affected these roads and disrupted traffic movement and causing inconvenience to the general public.

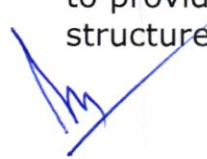

WAHEED UR REHMAN PARA**, to move for leave to introduce "A Bill to provide for vesting of ownership of State land in long-term occupants, regularization of tourism-related land and other lands in possession, and ensuring transparency and fairness in land ownership transfer in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir (**L.A. Private Members' Bill No.44 of 2025**)".

- 10) **MR. NIZAM-UD-DIN BHAT**, to move for leave to introduce," A Bill to provide for uniformity in the design, construction, and aesthetic of structures in the Kashmir Valley, to preserve its cultural and
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ecological landscape, to establish a regulatory authority for its enforcement, and to confer specific powers upon courts for the adjudication of disputes and violations" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 02 of 2026)**

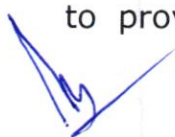

Private Member's Bill No. 07 of 2026)**

- 14) **PIRZADA FAROOQ AHMAD SHAH**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to prohibit import, manufacture or sale of polythene in Kashmir Valley and for matters committed therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 09 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 15) **MTR. SHAMIM FIRDOUS**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to create mass awareness among the people of all walks of life about breast cancer among females and to prevent breast cancer to provide access to free screening for the patients across the UT and to provide the fare financial assistance for those diagnosed with
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breast cancer and for matters connected therewith" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 12 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 16) **MR. GULAM AHMAD MIR**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the establishment of a residential and Technical University in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir to offer higher learning in various streams. The University will be set up by utilizing the funds of Society of Educational assistance and training (SEAT) Jammu and Kashmir" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 14 of 2026)**

- 17) **MR. TANVIR SADIQ**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the establishment of a Jammu and Kashmir Urban Commission for sustainable, inclusive, and planned urban development, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 15 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 18) **SHEIKH AHSAN AHMAD(PARDESI)**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for identification, allotment, and transfer of land for graveyards for the Muslim community in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, on concessional rates, and free of cost to families belonging to the Below Poverty Line category, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No.17 of 2026)**

Private Member's Bill No.23 of 2026)**

- 22) **AGA SYED MUNTAZIR MEHDI**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the establishment of a statutory Re-integration Commission in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir for the safe, voluntary, dignified and sustainable return and reintegration of Kashmiri Migrants, particularly Kashmiri Pandits; to facilitate reconciliation, social healing, cultural restoration and coexistence through institutional, community-based and rights-oriented mechanisms; and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 25 of 2026)**

- 23) **MR. ARJUN SINGH RAJU**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the proper management, governance, development, administration, and supervision of the Sarvadhara and Ghaladhar shrines and their surrounding pilgrimage areas, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 27 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 24) **MR. IFTKAR AHMED**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the right to free and timely emergency healthcare and essential medical services to every resident of the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir; to ensure availability of functional critical healthcare infrastructure including Intensive Care Units, Trauma Care Centers and Cardiac Catheterization Laboratories in all Government Medical Colleges; to provide free diagnostic services to Below Poverty Line families; to establish accountability mechanisms; and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 29 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 25) **MR. SHABIR AHMAD KULLAY**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for regulated utilization of the Hospital Development Fund for the welfare and payment of contractual employees working in Government hospitals in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir." **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 31 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 26) **SHRI RANBIR SINGH PATHANIA**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill further to amend the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, in its application to the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir, to provide for automatic revision of minimum wages based on Wholesale Price Index inflation and a spontaneous mechanism for the re-categorization of workers' skill levels. **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 35 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 27) **DR. DEVINDER KUMAR MANYAL**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the regularization and grant of permanent status to Daily Wagers, Casual Labourers and other similarly placed workers engaged in various Departments of the Government of Jammu and Kashmir since the year 1994; to ensure job security, parity in wages and social security benefits to such workers; and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto. **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 37 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 28) **MR. SHEIKH KHURSHEED AHMAD**, to move for leave to introduce "A Bill to impose a complete ban on the sale, consumption, storage, and transportation of liquor in the Kashmir Valley, in recognition of its social, religious, and security sensitivities **(L.A. Private Members' Bill No. 20 of 2025)"**.

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 29) **MR. NIZAM-UD-DIN BHAT**, to move for leave to introduce "A Bill to Prohibit Conversion of Agricultural land for Non-Agricultural Purposes and matters connected therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 01 of 2026)**

- 30) **MR. MUBARIK GUL**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the care, protection, dignity and welfare of Senior

Citizens by imposing a legal obligation upon children and legal heirs to maintain and support their parents and senior citizens, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 03 of 2026)**

Also to introduce the Bill.

- 31) **MR. JAVID HASSAN BAIG**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to rationalize the academic week for students of primary classes in schools in the Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir. **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 08 of 2026)**

- 32) **MIR SAIFULLAH**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the promotion, regulation, and development of tourism in Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir through sustainable and inclusive practices, the constitution of institutional mechanisms for planning and implementation, protection of fragile ecosystems, empowerment of local communities, and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No.10 of 2026)**

- 33) **MTR. SHAMIM FIRDOUS**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for comprehensive measures for all round development of women and for matters connected therewith or incidental thereto" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No. 13 of 2026)**

TANVIR SADIQ**, to move for leave to introduce, "A Bill to provide for the right of residents living in and around the lakes of Srinagar to construct and upgrade eco-friendly housing in a regulated and environmentally sustainable manner, and to harmonize the protection of fragile lake ecosystems with the constitutional right to dignified living" **(L.A. Private Member's Bill No.16 of 2026)**
