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(a)&(b) Yes Madam. The work for 4-laning of Visakhapatnam Port Road (Sabbaaram bypass to Sheelanagar road project) in Andhra Pradesh has been awarded in March, 2018 at a cost of about Rs. 550 crores with scheduled completion period of 18 months. Further, the work for 6-laning of Anandapuram to Anakapalle road stretch has also been awarded in February, 2018 at a cost of about Rs. 2010 crores. The scheduled completion period for this 6-laning project is 30 months.

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
