**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA  
STARRED QUESTION NO. 151\* FOR 27<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2018**

(a) to (c) This Ministry administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals. The Phase-II of this Scheme for establishment of 24 new medical colleges has been approved by Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs in its meeting held on 7th February, 2018. The objective of the Phase-II of the scheme is to ensure the availability of one medical college in every 3 Parliamentary Constituencies and one Government medical college in each State. 24 new medical colleges in 8 States/UT have been identified under this Scheme. The fund sharing ratio between the Central Government and States under the Scheme is 90:10 for NE/Special Category states and 60:40 for other States. The total cost of establishment of one Medical College under the scheme is Rs.250 crore. The State Governments were requested to identify locations of these 24 new medical colleges on Challenge mode. Out of 24 medical colleges, 12 have been approved till date. Funds to the tune of Rs.600 crore have been released to the State/UT Governments for the approved districts under the Scheme.
