Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has approved in principle, five metro projects across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is true that all these five metro projects would involve a sum of Rs. 1.07 lakh crore; and
- (d) if so, the cost involved on each metro project?

(a) & (b) After issuance of Metro Rail Policy-2017 in August, 2017, Government of India has granted "in principle" approval for taking up five metro rail projects for appraisal. The approval of these metro rail projects will depend upon their feasibility and availability of resources.

The details of these metro rail projects as received from respective state governments are as under:
