PMKVY IN BUNDELKHAND

1849. SHRI KUNWAR PUSHPENDRA SINGH CHANDEL:

WILL the MINISTER of SKILL DEVELOPMENT and ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras established and proposed to be set up in Bundelkhand after the inauguration of the PMKVY;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that contract of some of the agencies appointed to operate PMKKs in Bundelkhand have been cancelled;
- (c) if so, whether the Government is considering or considered to award new contract for starting the closed PMKKs in Bundelkhand; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship is promoting establishment of model and aspirational skill centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) in every district for imparting skill training through Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) 2016-20. As on 11.07.2018, 613 PMKKs have been allocated across 35 States and UTs covering 548 Districts and 468 Parliamentary Constituencies (PCs). Out of the 613 allocated PMKKs, 462 centres had been established.

There are 20 districts covering Bundelkhand and out of these 20 districts, Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs) have been allocated in 13 districts and established in 12 districts.

(b) to (d) PMKKs in the districts of Chitrakoot, Jalaun, Jhansi and Lalitpur were allocated to Don Bosco Tech Society, however, due to non-compliance to the timeline, as per PMKK Guidelines, to establish the centres the same were de-allocated. Post de-allocation of PMKKs in the 4 districts (Chitrakoot, Jalaun, Jhansi and Lalitpur), re-allocation was initiated, and the application was invited to set up in the said districts under PMKK Phase 4 through RFP mode. As on date, PMKK has been allocated in the district of Jalaun covering the Parliamentary Constituency of Jalaun to AISECT limited.
