Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has taken any measure to improve the basic amenities in various ESI hospitals in the country, if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Kerala; and
- (b)the specific action taken by the Government to ensure efficient medical care in ESI hospitals?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

- (a): Various measures taken to improve amenities in ESI Hospitals are as under:-
 - 1. Employees' State Insurance Corporation provides Rs.200/- per Insured Persons (IP) per annum over and above ceiling of Rs. 3000/- per IP to the State Government, where the bed occupancy in all the State Employees' State Insurance Scheme Hospitals is more than 70% during the last financial year.
 - 2. Enhancement of 50% of bed strength, if bed occupancy is more than 70% in ESIC/ESIS hospitals for the last consecutive three years.
 - 3. Evening OPD for senior citizen & differently abled patients
 - 4. 24X7 medical helpline
 - 5. Behavioural training to the staff
 - 6. "May I help you" facility for patients/attendants.
 - 7. Feedback system for indoor patients.
 - 8. Complete immunization facilities.
 - 9. Facility of Yoga.
 - 10. Ayush facilities.
- (b): ESI Corporation has issued instructions to set-up Intensive Care Unit (ICU)/ High Dependency Unit (HDU) in all ESIC hospitals.
