Employment Information Centres

(a) whether the Government has issued instructions to the States for setting up Employment Information Centres (EICs) in each village for job related information and if so, the details thereof; (b) whether these instructions are being followed by the State Governments and if so, the details thereof; (c) the names of the villages where EICs have been set up during each of the last three years and the current year, Statewise; (d) the time by which EICs are likely to be set up in each village; and (e) the steps taken by the Government to set up Bureau for Private Sector in the Employment Exchange of each district for providing job opportunities in the private sect

Export of Raw Sugar to China
