- (a) whether providing Group 'A' status and pay in level 10 to Delhi, Andaman and Nicobar Island Civil Service (DANICS) disturbs vertical relativity in the system; and
- (b) if so, the reasons for not disturbing the so called vertical relativity as already Goa, Mizoram and Arunanchal Pradesh are Group 'A' services which are feeder cadre for IAS (AGMUT) like DANICS?
