ADOPT A HERITAGE SCHEME

1160. SHRI MULLAPPALLY RAMACHANDRAN: DR. SHASHI THAROOR:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a pre-requisite for prospective Monument Mitras to partner with experts in the field of conservation of heritage/ancient buildings, before applying under the 'Adopt a Heritage Scheme' and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (b) whether the Government has nominated any experts in the field of conservation of heritage sites/ancient structures, as members of the Oversight and Vision Committees for all the Monuments adopted under the 'Adopt a Heritage Scheme';
- (c) if so, the details thereof Monument-wise, along with the period of professional experience of such persons nominated in the field of conservation;
- (d) the present status of implementation of "Adopt a Heritage" scheme and the details of MoUs signed so far; and
- (e) the details of monuments identified and proposed to be put under the scheme?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TOURISM (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI K.J. ALPHONS)

(a) to (c): Under the "Apni Dharohar-Apni Pehchaan" Adopt a Heritage Project, the Monument Mitras are responsible for operation and maintenance and development/up-gradation of tourist amenities, in the non- core areas of the monument. The conservation of heritage/ancient buildings/monuments does not come under the 'Apni Dharohar, Apni Pehchaan - Adopt a Heritage'

project of the Ministry of Tourism. Hence, there is no pre-requisite for prospective Monument Mitras to partner with conservation experts.

- (d): At present, 11 Memorandum of Understanding (MoU's) have been signed with the Monument Mitras. The details of MoUs signed are attached at Annexure.
- (e): The prospective Monument Mitras are free to select a monument/heritage/tourist site of their interest under the 'Apni Dharohar, Apni Pehchaan Adopt a Heritage' project.
