- (a) whether the Government is aware that the residents of DDA LIG flats, Block-GH-3, Sector-28, Rohini are not getting drinkable water through pipelines so far;**
- (b) if so, the reasons for not providing potable water;**
- (c) the initiative taken by DDA to meet the requirement so far; and**
- (d) the reasons for delay and the time by which the residents are likely to get drinkable water adequately through pipelines?**
