(a) The details of Indian Army soldiers killed on the India-Pakistan border (LOC) due to terrorist attacks during last two years are as under:-

Year	Fatal Casualties suffered by Army during tactical actions
2017	13
2018	12

(b) & (c): All the forward posts are adequately strengthened to withstand terrorist attacks. Continuous improvements, including the usage of modern technology, in the defences are made to make them more robust and resilient. The Army also carries out indepth analysis of the terrorist incidents and security breaches that are identified with various incidents.
