**(a) & (b): Zone wise breakup of number of Unmanned Level Crossings (UMLCs) i.e. level crossings (without gates) as on 01.04.2018 in the State of Maharashtra was as under:**

**(c): 3 accidents took place at UMLCs in Maharashtra State during last three years and the current year (up to January, 2019). No death took place due to these accidents at unmanned level crossings.**

**(d): It was decided to eliminate all UMLCs on BG by March 2020. All UMLCs on BG are now eliminated including the State of Maharashtra.**
