Statement in reply to parts (a), (b) & (c) of the Starred (*) Question No. 267 for answer on 11.07.2019 regarding 'Upgradation of Airports'.

- (a): Airports Authority of India (AAI) owns and maintains 11 airports in Gujarat including two Civil Enclaves at Bhuj and Jamnagar.
- (b) & (c): Yes, Sir. Based on the request of the Government of Gujarat, the Union Government has approved construction of new international airports at Dholera and Rajkot. Further, Vadodara and Surat airports have been upgraded to international standards by AAI. Ahmedabad airport is an international airport and Surat Airport is a Customs notified airport where international flight operations are also permitted. However, development and upgradation of airports to international standards is a continuous process which is undertaken by AAI from time to time depending upon commercial viability, traffic demand, availability of land etc.
