(a) & (b): Airports Authority of India (AAI) is providing free Wi Fi service to the passengers at Calicut International Airport at the departure side of the International terminal and the entire domestic terminal (arrival and departure both). The Wi Fi service is being provided through the service provider M/s Firefly Networks. The Wi Fi service provided at Calicut airport is functioning properly and allowing passengers to use free Wi Fi upto a data limit of 200 MB or 45 minutes, whichever is earlier. AAI has also approved a plan to provide free Wi Fi upto 45 minutes at the arrival side of the international terminal with probable date of commissioning as 31.08.2019.
