CONSTRUCTION OF CROSSROAD/FLYOVER

704. SHRI ANURAG SHARMA:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a crossroad with a cost of 17.5 crore rupees was proposed to be constructed at the location on Gwalior Road Army Airstrip connecting east-west four-lane corridor under Golden Quadrilateral project in Jhansi district of Uttar Pradesh and if so, the details and the present status thereof;
- (b) the reasons for delay in construction of the said crossroad/flyover; and
- (c) the time by which construction of the said crossroad/flyover is likely to be started and completed?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) No sir. At present, there is no such proposal for construction of cross road on Gwalior road army airstrip. However, there is a provision for construction of a flyover at that location. Construction of this flyover had been stopped by 664 Army Aviation Squadron (R&O), Jhansi due to safety concern.
