- (a) In order to align the objective of NCC training with the task of nation building due focus is being laid towards training of NCC cadets in social service and community development activities for nation building and social upliftment. The cadets are also being trained for skill development, soft skills, leadership, etc. Training programmes are also being undertaken in areas like Atmanirbhar Bharat, Fit India Movement, Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat, Swachh Bharat, Jal Shakti Abhiyan, etc.
- (b) & (c) Government has set up a Coordination Group under the aegis of Department of Youth Affairs; with National Cadet Corps (NCC), National Service Scheme (NSS), Nehru Yuva Kendra Sangthan (NYKS), Bharat Scout and Guides (BSG) and Hindustan Scouts and Guides (HSG); to ensure better coordination and faster dissemination of youth related schemes and proper implementation.
