Generation of Solar Power

Will the **NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY** be pleased to state that:-

(a) the criteria followed by the Government for setting up of solar parks in the country along with the targets set by the Government for generation of solar power in the country by the year 2022 and the achievements made by the Government in this direction so far;

(b) whether the Government is lagging behind in achieving the targets set for the generation of solar power in the country;

(c) if so, the details thereof along with the quantum of solar power generated in the country during each of the last three years and the current year, State/UTwise;

(d) the funds provided by the Government for generation and creation of 130 additional capacity of solar power in the country during the said period, State/UTwise; and

(e) the other steps taken/being taken by the Government for promoting the generation and use of solar power and bringing transparency in utilisation of funds for the purpose?

- (d) whether sufficient amount as compensation is being paid to the victims and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the corrective steps taken or being taken by the Government in consultation with States to avoid pothole fatalities?

(c) whether the Government proposes to register the presently working open wells and bore wells across the country so as to maintain the record and control further exploitation of ground water; and

(d) if so, the details thereof and the rules the Government proposes to draft in this regard?

Work on NH-104
