### **Dispensing with the practice of making Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs regarding Government Business for the following week**

At the meeting of Hon'ble Speaker with Leaders of Parties in Lok Sabha held on 30 January, 2020, it was decided to dispense with the practice of making Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs on the last working day of the week, usually Fridays, regarding Government Business for the following week.

2. In pursuance of this decision, the practice of making Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs on the last working day of the week, usually Fridays, regarding Government Business for the following week has been dispensed with and this decision has been made effective with effect from third session of Seventeenth Lok Sabha.

3. Further, in the meeting it has also been decided that now on the last working day of the week, usually Fridays, instead of Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs regarding Government Business for the following week, matters under Rule 377 shall be permitted to be raised by members. It is to be specifically noted that the text of the matters admitted to be raised on Fridays shall be limited to 100 words.
