LIMIT ON PRIVATE MEMBER'S BILLS, AMENDMENTS TO MOTION OF THANKS AND CUT MOTIONS TO A DEMAND

Members are informed that the Hon'ble Speaker has issued the following directions:-

- (i) A Member shall be permitted to introduce not more than three Private Member's Bills during a session. Where notices of Bills received from a Member are in excess of three, the first three admissible notices shall be taken into consideration, unless the Member has indicated the preference.
- (ii) A Member shall be permitted to move not more than ten amendments to the Motion of Thanks on the Address by the President or not more than ten Cut Motions to a Demand for Grant. Where notices of amendments to the Motion of Thanks or of Cut Motions to a Demand received from a Member are in excess of ten, the first ten admissible amendments or Cut Motions, as the case may be, shall be taken into consideration, unless the Member has indicated the preference.
