RESOLUTIONS

12. FURTHER DISCUSSION on the following resolution moved by Shri Kunwar Pushpendra Singh Chandel on the 21st June, 2019 :-

“Having regard to the fact that due to scarcity of water and unavailability of fodder for cattle in the Bundelkhand region of the State of Uttar Pradesh, the people of the region are forced to leave their cows to graze in the open, which is popularly known as `Anna Pratha', and which causes damage to the standing crops, this House urges upon the Government to take steps to construct a network of canals from the proposed Ken-Betwa riverlinking project in order to inter-connect and replenish the dams and ponds to overcome the problem of water scarcity and practice of Anna Pratha in the region.”.

Construction of canals through Ken-Betwa river linking project to overcome the problem of water scarcity and stray cows in the Bundelkhand region.

13. SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA to move :-

"Having regard to the fact that the farmers of the Bundelkhand region in the State of Uttar Pradesh have inadequate irrigation facilities, low agricultural yield in comparison to other parts of the State and inconsistency in land holdings, this House urges upon the Government to formulate a more effective scheme for the welfare of the small and marginal farmers of the Bundelkhand region."

Formulation of more effective schemes for the welfare of small and marginal farmers of the Bundelkhand region in the State of Uttar Pradesh.

14. SHRI SHRIRANG APPA BARNE to move :-

"This House expresses its grave concern over the population explosion in our country, which, if not taken care of, would lead to demographic catastrophe in the next fifty years, and urges upon the Government to implement a stringent policy aiming at population control at the earliest."

Implementation of a stringent population control policy.

15. DR. ALOK KUMAR SUMAN to move :-

"Keeping in view that:-

(a) a large number of people residing in Gopalganj, Siwan and adjoining areas in the State of Bihar, who work in Gulf countries and generate huge foreign exchange for our country, have to travel to New Delhi for their onward journey to Gulf nations;

(b) there is no direct air connectivity between Gopalganj and New Delhi; and

(c) the Saveya Airport in Gopalganj district in the State of Bihar, which has unlawful encroachment at present, may be refurbished with state of the art technologies, to run air services,

this House urges upon the Government to take immediate steps to provide direct air connectivity between Gopalganj and New Delhi by making the Saveya Airport, Gopalganj functional on priority basis in order to mitigate the problems being faced by people of the region in travelling to different parts of the country."
