Dispensing with the practice of making Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs regarding Government Business for the following week

At the meeting of Hon'ble Speaker with Leaders of Parties in Lok Sabha held on 30 January, 2020, it was decided to dispense with the practice of making Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs on the last working day of the week, usually Fridays, regarding Government Business for the following week.

- 2. In pursuance of this decision, the practice of making Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs on the last working day of the week, usually Fridays, regarding Government Business for the following week has been dispensed with and this decision has been made effective with effect from third session of Seventeenth Lok Sabha.
- 3. Further, in the meeting it has also been decided that now on the last working day of the week, usually Fridays, instead of Submissions on the Statement of Minister of Parliamentary Affairs regarding Government Business for the following week, matters under Rule 377 shall be permitted to be raised by members. It is to be specifically noted that the text of the matters admitted to be raised on Fridays shall be limited to 100 words.

The material will enrich the Parliamentary Museum & Archives and be useful for research work. If desired, the material received would be returned after making necessary copies. Any secretarial assistance in sorting out and listing the material will be made available to them.

The Parliamentary Museum and Archives have 724 books on/by Members of Parliament. Members who are desirous of consulting these books may contact the PMA.

The Photo Archives too has a collection of 19,790 photographs relating to Parliamentary events and passport size photographs of Members of Parliament from 1st to 17th Lok Sabha including two hundred photographs of Freedom Fighters lodged in Cellular Jail during freedom struggle received from the Government of Andaman and Nicobar Island. All these Photographs have been digitized and can be retrieved with a click of mouse with help of keywords through software available in the branch.
