1. 9 (Nine) Arecanut Processing Units owned by Farmer Cooperatives have been set up at a subsidy of ₹41.00 lakh per unit, including infrastructure, machinery, solar component and trial marketing grant.

2. 5 (five) Cashew Processing Units owned by Farmer Cooperatives have been set up at a subsidy of ₹20.00 lakh per unit, including infrastructure, machinery and trial marketing grant.

(a) Sir, Yes, methodology adopted for the demand forecast for the State of Meghalaya for:

MePGCL submitted herewith the forecasting generation for Financial Year 2026-27 to Financial Year 2029-30 is as per Statement placed on the Table of the House which may be useful for forecasting the power demand in the State up to Financial Year 2029-30.

MePDCL : Methodology adopted for the demand forecast for the State of Meghalaya up to Financial Year 2029–30 has been prepared using a structured and data-driven approach aligned with the methodology prescribed by the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) under its STELLAR framework which is the application software for long-term demand assessment and resource planning.

- (b) The data sources and assumptions that were relied upon? (b) Sir,

The forecast relies upon the following data sources:

- Historical sales and peak demand data of MePDCL;
- System load curve and load factor data;
- AT&C (Aggregate Technical and Commercial) loss trajectory and loss reduction plans;
- Official State GSDP projections and population statistics;
- Relevant CEA and regional demand projections for cross-verification.

Key assumptions include:

- Moderate and realistic GSDP growth consistent with State economic outlook;
- Gradual increase in per capita consumption;
- Continued consumer addition across categories;
- Moderate industrial growth based on existing and likely developments;
- Progressive reduction in AT&C losses; and Conservative accounting of energy efficiency measures and distributed renewable penetration.

- (c) Whether any independent or expert validation was undertaken? (c) Sir, Yes.

Delays, where they occur, are generally case – specific and may arise due to non – finalization of seniority lists, pending disciplinary or vigilance clearance, non – availability of complete ACR / APAR records, delay in receipt of requisite documents from the concerned offices, or court cases affecting seniority or eligibility.

To ensure timely conduct of DPCs, the Personnel & Administrative Reforms (B) Department has issued Office Memorandum No. PER (AR) 74/2024/1 dated 24th July, 2024 prescribing Standard Operating Procedures.

Umngot River

(a) The efforts laid out to clean the Umngot River by the Project Management Unit- Myllem in the on-going Shillong- Dawki Road Project?

(a) Sir, in compliance with the directions issued by the Meghalaya State Pollution Control Board, the National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. (NHIDCL) has deposited a sum of ₹15,00,000/- (Fifteen Lakh only) towards Environmental Compensation (EC). Further, the NHIDCL has taken immediate mitigation measures to rectify the situation including the debris removal, slope stabilization and river protection measures. In addition, the NHIDCL through its contractor has deployed dedicated personnel at the site to regularly monitor the situation in relation to cleanliness of the river and ensure that the construction works do not pollute or cause any siltation in the river in any manner. Further, the user agency has also discontinued sand washing activities in Wah Umsong River near Laitlyngkot which is a tributary to Umngot river, since the sand washing activity seems to have contributed to turbidity in the Umngot River.

(b) Whether the Standard Operating Procedure as per the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 being strictly followed?

(b) Yes, Sir, the Standard Operating Procedure prescribed under S.O. 1223(E) dated 17th March, 2025 of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 is being strictly followed by the Project Management Unit.

Rajabala Substation

(a) Sir, the 33/11 KV Sub-Station having capacity of 1x5 MVA at Gutlibari is being constructed under NERPSIP Funding and being executed by PGCIL. The target to complete the substation is within the current Financial Year.

(b) The total numbers of unelectrified households in Rajabala's remote border areas?

(b) Sir, 594 households under Selsella Distribution Sub-Division and 747 households under Phulbari Distribution Sub-Division are yet to be electrified.

(c) The targets for full coverage for the year 2026-27?

(c) Sir, efforts are being made to electrify maximum number of unelectrified households during the Financial Year 2026-27 under Additional Household Electrification (AHHE) under RDSS.

(d) The solar initiatives that are proposed for flood-prone Rajabala villages?

(d) Sir, the Government of Meghalaya, under the CM Solar Mission, has proposed Solar Hybrid Inverter Systems and Solar Off Grid Inverter Systems for L.P. Schools and Small Households/PMAY Beneficiaries. A total of 96 household beneficiaries comprising selected small households and PMAY beneficiaries have been identified for the installation of Solar Hybrid Inverter Systems. Additionally, 43 Lower Primary Schools in the region have been earmarked for the installation of Solar Off Grid Inverter Systems to ensure uninterrupted power supply.

(a) The progress made in the demarcation of the Assam-Meghalaya Inter-State boundary and the erection of border pillars pursuant to the Memorandum of Understanding signed between the two States?

(a) Sir, the process of demarcation of the boundary and erection of boundary pillars in the areas of differences as per MoU signed between Meghalaya and Assam on the 29th March, 2022 has started and is under progress.
