BUDGET SESSION

FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 27th 2026

The House met at 10 a.m. with Hon'ble Speaker in the Chair and sat till 02:24 p.m.

The day was allotted for Government Business.

1. Questions

Question Nos. 221 to 223 were taken up and disposed of.

Shri SNIAWBHALANG DHAR: Mr. Speaker, I rise to raise the Point of Order under **Rule 300** on the speech made by Shri Ardent Miller Basaiawmoit, Member from Nongkrem, on the Short Duration Discussion relating to report on the Reservation Policy, on the 25th February, 2026 while participating in the discussion, the Hon'ble Member Shri Ardent Miller Basaiawmoit has referred on the term "**Khasi**" and not inclusive of "**Jaintia**". So, as we all know as per Reservation Policy it is specifically reserved for "**Khasi and Jaintia**". So, therefore, it should always to be referred as "**Khasi and Jaintia**" whenever we discuss the Reservation Policy. So, I therefore, request you Hon'ble Speaker to put on the record on the proceeding of the House that it should always be referred as '**Khasi and Jaintia**' whenever we refer to the Reservation Policy. This is my submission.

SPEAKER: That is only the mind of the mover who brought the Short Duration Discussion, but as per records it is always referred as "**Khasi and Jaintia**". So, I put the records as "**Khasi and Jaintia**". My decision is this.
