- (a) Sir, at present, Rajpur (Bhaitbari) Veterinary Dispensary is functional with 2 (two) deputed staff i.e., 1 (one) Veterinary Assistant and 1 (one) Chowkidar.
- (b) Sir, it is not fully functional as there are no regular staff. It is partially functional with 2 (two) deputed staff without any doctor.
- (c) Sir, limited facilities are available for minor cases.
- (d) Yes, Sir.
- (e) Sir, there are 2 (two) staff :-
 1. Shri Muktadur Islam, Veterinary Assistant, deputed from Vigilance Unit, District Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Office, Tura.

2. Shri Sirazul Islam, Chowkidar, deputed from Rongadatgre Poultry Farm, under Sub-Divisional Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Office, Dadenggre, West Garo Hills.

(f) The sanctioned staff pattern for the Sub-centre?
