Sir, the total land area afforested by different Government Departments in the whole State of Meghalaya during 2024-25 is 9,297.18 Hectares.

ICDS Center at Umpling

Sir, construction of Anganwadi building under Umpling Dong Umbah Anganwadi Centre known by the name Umpling 6 - had already been sanctioned during Financial year 2025-26 in convergence with MGNREGES (C&RD Block).

Umpling Dongshaneng Anganwadi Centre is an existing centre by the name Umpling 5. The construction of new Anganwadi building will be taken up in the next phase of construction.

- (a) Sir, the villages of Ummir and Mawkhanu in the Mawryngkneng Constituency are part of the New Shillong Township master plan.

Promotion of Agro Products from Mawryngkneng

4. Will the Minister in-charge Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare be pleased to state:-

(a) Whether the Government has any Scheme to promote Agro Products from Mawryngkneng Constituency for National and International markets?

Dr. M. AMPAREEN LYNGDOH (Minister in-charge Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare)

(a) Yes, Sir, currently the Department is implementing the Mission Value Chain Development for North Eastern Region (MOVCDNER) in the State. One FPO has been established under Phase III of the scheme in Diengpasoh and another FPO is currently established in Mawryngkneng under Meghalaya State Organic Mission. The Scheme will eventually facilitate marketing of certain Agro products produced under Mawryngkneng Constituency to national markets and perhaps international markets.

The Organic Certification process of the farmlands under the FPOs is underway. Further, a component under the scheme Directorate of Food Processing provides platform to entrepreneurs to showcase and connect their processed products for national and international markets.

- (b) The support being given to farmers cultivating high-demand crops such as Buckwheat?
- (b) Yes, Sir, support is being given to farmers by the Department of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare in collaboration with the Meghalaya Farmers (Empowerment) Commission for cultivating Buckwheat.
- (c) Whether the Government will facilitate export linkages with countries like Japan?
- (c) Yes, Sir.

Status of Small Stone Miners in Meghalaya

- 5. Will the Chief Minister be pleased to state:-
- (a) Whether the Government has any proposal to review or relax the present ban on small-scale stone mining?
- (b) The steps taken to safeguard the livelihood of miners in Mawryngkneng and other affected areas?
- (a) Sir, currently there is no ban on small scale stone mining if such small scale mining is carried out in accordance with Meghalaya Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016.
- (b) Sir, a committee has been constituted for reviewing the provisions of Meghalaya Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2016 for expeditious grant of mining or quarry permit in respect of traditional mining of minor minerals vide Government Notification No. FOR.125/2003/ Pt.II/ Vol.I/562, dated 16.09.2024 headed by the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister (PWD, etc.), Meghalaya. The Committee had held two (02) sittings dated 22.11.2024 and 28.01.2025 in this regard and submitted its report to the State Government.

Further, vide letter dated 01.04.2025 the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Meghalava had requested the Hon'ble Minister of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India for exemption from the requirement of obtaining Environmental Clearance for traditional quarrying of stone boulders in Meghalaya. Referring to the provisions of the Notification of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, dated 28.03.2020 of the Environmental Impact Assessment, the Hon'ble Minister for Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India stated that at present there are no enabling provisions to consider the request for exemption of traditional stone boulder quarrying from the requirement of Environmental Clearance because Clause 13 of Appendix IX of EIA notification has been set aside by the Hon'ble High Court of Patna in Abhay Kumar Vrs Union of India vide their judgement dated 07.03.2024.

- (c) Whether rehabilitation or alternative Livelihood Schemes have been initiated?
- (c) Sir, does not arise in view at (b) above.

Umkhen River Biosecurity Measures

- 6. Will the Minister in-charge Public Health Engineering be pleased to state:-
- (a) The steps taken to ensure the cleanliness and biosecurity of the Umkhen River?
- (a) Sir, the steps taken to ensure the cleanliness and biosecurity of the Umkhen River are as follows:-

- i) The Meghalaya State Pollution Board (MSPCB), Shillong has issued Public Notice on Prohibition on burning, throwing, burying of waste along the catchment/tributaries of Umkhen River vide Notification No.MPCB/SWM-5/2006/2021-22/74, dt. 10.03.2022 to control indiscriminate dumping of Solid waste construction etc.
- ii) Chain link along the bank of river Umkhen at Thembasuk, Madanryting has been installed in a stretch measuring about 60 meters.
- (b) Whether there is any plan for plantation and catchment protection to maintain water flow for the New Shillong Water Supply Scheme?
- (b) Sir, the State is currently implementing the comprehensive MegARISE project under the Meghalaya Basin Development Authority, funded by KfW Germany. The project commenced from 2022-23 and is expected to end by 2029-2030. This significant initiative is specifically designed to address catchment protection and watershed management challenges in the two critical catchments i.e., Umiew and Ganol Catchment that supply water to Shillong and Tura, with particular focus on maintaining sustainable water flow for critical projects including the New Shillong Supply Scheme. The MegARISE project will promote forestry and agro-forestry plantations, soil conservation measures, integrated catchment and management through close coordination with other Government Departments.

- (c) The agencies entrusted with monitoring water quality?
- (c) Sir, the following agencies are entrusted with monitoring water quality:-
- i) The Meghalaya State Pollution Board (MSPCB), Shillong has been entrusted for monitoring the water bodies of Meghalaya under the National Water Monitoring Programme (NWMP) sponsored by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB), Delhi. Monitoring of water quality of Umkhen River is carried out under this project.
- ii) The PHE Department monitors water quality pertaining to supplied drinking water only. Monitoring of water quality of drinking water is done at PHED laboratories across the State. Currently, the Department conducts water testing twice a year for bacteriological parameters and once a year for chemical parameters.

(i) Diengpasoh?

(i) Yes, the Shillong Diengpasoh Road was being widened under the scheme "Improvement including widening to Two Lane Standard of the Balance Length of Shillong - Diengpasoh Road from 14.00 KM to 21.20 KM upto Shillong By-pass (Length = 7.200 KM)" amounting to ₹5586.633 (L) and the same has been recently completed.

Further, estimates have been prepared for repairing of the remaining roads and the same has been submitted under the following nomenclatures:

- (a) Constn. i/c MBT of internal road at Diengpasoh Dong Sharum (L = 500.00m) amounting to ₹98.141 (L).
- (b) Constn. i/c MBT of internal road at Diengpasoh Lumsohprian (L = 1.68 KM) amounting to ₹461.58 (L).

(ii) Mawlynrei?

(ii) Yes, the estimate for the repair work of the internal road is at present under preparation.

The repair work for the main road has been taken up under the scheme "Improvement including widening and Metalling & Blacktopping of Nongrah - Mawlynrei Road (L = 5.25 KM) - Portion from 1500.00m - 4615.00m" amounting to ₹407.08 (L).

The estimate for the repairing of other roads has been recently sanctioned vide A.A. letter No. PWD/PWD-R/12464/2425/CON/291, Dt.25.03.2025 for an amount of ₹89.24 (L) under the nomenclature "Widening including strengthening of an existing Nongrah - Mawlynrei Road (L = 5.25 KM). Portion from 2nd KM of Nongrah - Mawlynrei Road towards GTC Gate Mawlynrei (L = 0.435 KM)".

(iii) Puriang?

- (iii) Yes, the estimate for repairing of internal road at Puriang has been submitted under the following schemes:
- (a) Strengthening of weak pavement of internal roads at Puriang by laying 1 layer WBM Gr-3 and PMC (Total length = 1.022 KM) amounting to ₹89.00 (L).
- (b) Construction including Metalling and Blacktopping of internal link road at Iew Rim Puriang (Total length = 0.398 KM) amounting to ₹94.305 (L).

(iv) Kut?

(iv) Yes, the repair works for internal road at Kut has been taken up under the scheme "Improvement including Metalling and Blacktopping of internal roads at Puriang Kut Village (L = 1.40 KM)" amounting to ₹150.88 (L).

(v) Tynring?

(v) Yes, the repair work for the roads at Tynring has been taken up under the scheme "Re-surfacing of Tynring Village Road, all internal village road including construction of pucca road side drain in selected location (Length = 5.670 KM)" for an amount of ₹362.95 (L).
