- (1) Discussion and Voting on First Batch of the Demands for Supplementary Grants, 2026-27.

(i) DEMAND NO.1 - STATE LEGISLATURE:

Shri Y. Khemchand Singh, Chief Minister to move :

“that a supplementary sum not exceeding Rs. 5,20,00,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2027 in respect of Demand No. 1 - State Legislature.”

(ii) DEMAND NO. 3 - SECRETARIAT :

Shri Y. Khemchand Singh, Chief Minister to move :

"that a supplementary sum not exceeding Rs. 6,34,94,000/- be granted to defray the charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending 31st March, 2027 in respect of Demand No. 3 - Secretariat."

(iii) DEMAND NO. 5 - FINANCE DEPARTMENT :
