1. SUMMONING, SITTING AND PROROGATION OF THE PUNJAB LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY

The Sixteenth Punjab Legislative Assembly was summoned by an order of the Governor, dated the 19th November, 2025, to meet for its Tenth (Special) Session at Bhai Jaita Ji Memorial, Sri Anandpur Sahib, District Rupnagar at 1.00 P.M. on the 24th November, 2025 and the House adjourned sine-die on the same day i.e. 24th November, 2025. It was later prorogued by an order of the Governor, dated the 17th December, 2025.

During the Session, the Sabha held one sitting.

2. PROGRAMME OBSERVED

Following two Official Resolutions were moved & carried unanimously: - i) Expressing its deepest reverence and pays tribute to the great Sikh Guru on the historic occasion of the 350 th year of martyrdom of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji; and ii) Declaring the three Takht cities i.e. Darbar Sahib corridor at Sri Amritsar Sahib, Sri Anandpur Sahib and Sri Damdama Sahib Talwandi Sabo as official holy cities of Punjab. Imposing there in ban on sale & consumption of meat, alcohol, tobacco & other intoxicants.

4. RESOLUTIONS

1. The following resolution was moved on the 24th November, 2025 by Sardar Harjot Singh Bains, Education Minister, Punjab: -

"On the historic occasion of the 350th year of martyrdom of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji, this House, expresses its deepest reverence and pays tribute to the great Sikh Guru and humbly bows down in respect, devotion and faith.

WHEREAS Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji laid down his life in defence of the Kashmiri Pandits' right to practise their faith freely and upheld the principles of religious freedom, human rights and dignity;

AND WHEREAS his supreme sacrifice has been a beacon of inspiration for generations, promoting values of courage, compassion and unwavering commitment to justice;

AND WHEREAS the people of Punjab, irrespective of their religious inclination, have immense pride in the Guru's legacy and contributions to the rich cultural and spiritual heritage of the region;

NOW, THEREFORE, this House resolves to:

1. Pay its humble tributes to Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji and honour his memory by observing his 350th martyrdom anniversary with due solemnity and reverence.
2. Commend the Punjab Government's efforts in organising various events and programmes to commemorate this occasion, including the Special Session of the Vidhan Sabha, Nagar Kirtans, Kirtan Darbars, Light and Sound shows/Drone shows dedicated to the life and legacy of Guru Sahib and Sarv Dharam Sammelan.
3. Urge the Government to continue promoting the values of secularism, universal brotherhood and human rights, as exemplified by Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji.
4. Resolve to draw inspiration from the Guru's life and teachings to work towards the welfare and prosperity of the people of Punjab, promoting peace, tolerance and harmony in the society. "

The motion was put to the vote of the House and carried unanimously.

2. The following resolution was moved on the 24th November, 2025 by the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab: -

"On the occasion dedicated to 350th martyrdom anniversary of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji, the special session of the Punjab Legislative Assembly being held at the holy land of Sri Anandpur Sahib is truly historic. I believe and I am confident and other Members of this House would also believe that our revered Gurus have always upheld the philosophy of Sarbat da Bhala (Welfare of all). The supreme sacrifice of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Sahib ji was also made for the protection of human rights. To establish Anandpur Sahib, he purchased land here and settled this city himself. The only son of Guru Sahib, Sri Guru Gobind Singh ji spent nearly 30 years on this holy land. While staying here, he also founded Khalsa Panth for the defence of the nation and to stand against tyranny. Among the four Sahibzadas of Sri Guru Gobind Singh Ji, three Sahibzadas were also born here and the sacrifice of Sahibzadas stands unmatched anywhere in history. So out of the five takhts established by the Guru Sahib, three of these have also been bestowed upon us on the land of Punjab. Sri Akal Takht Sahib which stands magnificent in Sri Amritsar- the holy city founded by Sri Guru Ramdas Ji- is also situated here. The Takht of Sri Damdama Sahib of Malwa is situated in Talwandi Sabo. Keeping in view the long standing demand and with a view that this session of the Punjab Vidhan Sabha be remembered forever in the annals of history, this House today recommends that the State Government should decide to declare Darbar Sahib Corridor at Sri Amritsar Sahib, Sri Anandpur Sahib and Sri Damdama Sahib Talwandi Sabo, all three Takht cities, as official holy cities of Punjab. The long standing and persistent demand of the Sangat be fulfilled by imposing a ban on the sale and consumption of meat, alcohol, tobacco and other intoxicants here by closing meat shops, liquor shops, cigarette shops and drug stores. These cities are not only religious centers but also symbols of our cultural heritage. Therefore, this demand does not pertain to any party, caste or religion rather it is necessary to take this step to preserve our heritage and to promote it globally.

Along with this, an interfaith (Sarv Dharm) committee related to all religious places be formed in these cities, comprising representatives of all religions. The Punjab Government shall allocate the necessary budget for the development, cleanliness, security and promotion of religious tourism in these holy cities and shall also seek financial aid from the Central Government."

Clarification/Note- Regarding the said resolution passed by the Punjab Vidhan Sabha, it has been clarified by the Hon'ble Speaker, Punjab Vidhan Sabha as per the discussion held with the Hon'ble Member (Hon'ble Chief Minister) who moved the resolution that the words "Corridor of Darbar Sahib at Sri Amritsar Sahib" mentioned in the presented resolution meant "Old Amritsar city (Walled City of Amritsar)"
