FRIDAY, THE 20th MARCH, 2026

PRESENT

The House met in the Assembly House, Agartala at 11:00 A.M on Friday the 20th March, 2026 with the Hon'ble Speaker Shri Ram Pada Jamatia in the chair, the Hon'ble chief Minister, the Hon'ble Deputy Speaker, 12 (Twelve) Hon'ble Ministers and 41 (Forty-one) Hon'ble Members being present in the House.

I. QUESTIONS

i) Admitted Double starred Short Notice Question No. 1 and Admitted Starred Question Nos. 13, 37, 67, 73 and 81 were answered orally on the floor of the House and all supplementary questions raised by Hon'ble Members there to were also answered orally.

IV. STATEMENT MADE BY HON'BLE CHIEF MINISTER

Professor (Dr.) Manik Saha, Hon'ble Chief Minister made a Statement under Rule 361 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the Tripura Legislative Assembly regarding, unexpected death of Angel Chakma, student of Tripura at the place of Uttarakhand, Dehradun.

V. REPORTING OF PETITIONS

The Hon'ble Speaker announced before the House that the 15 (Fifteen) numbers of petition submitted to the Assembly and duly countersigned by the Hon'ble Members namely Shri Nayan Sarkar, Shri Ramu Das, Smt. Antara Sankar Deb and Shri Birajit Singha in respect of people demand in the Assembly Constituencies - Belonia, Pratapgarh (sc), Kamalasagar and Kailashahar. The Hon'ble Speaker requested the Secretary, Tripura Legislative Assembly to report the petitions before the House.

A. "The Maharaja Bir Bikram University (Amendment) Bill, 2025 (The Tripura Bill No. 7 of 2025)."

Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department moved for Leave of the House to introduce the Bill.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was introduced.

The Motion for Consideration of the Bill was moved by Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department.

The Motion for consideration was adopted and clause by clause Consideration of the Bill was taken up.

The Clause 1 to 3 were adopted

The Title of the Bill was also adopted.

Then, the proposal 'Bill be passed' was moved by Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was passed by the House.

B. "Science Technology and Allied Skill University, Tripura Bill, 2026 (The Tripura Bill No. 09 of 2026)"

Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department moved for Leave of the House to introduce the Bill.

The Motion was Put to Voice vote and the Bill was introduced.

The Motion for Consideration of the Bill was moved by Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department.

The Motion for Consideration was adopted and clause by clause Consideration of the Bill was taken up.

The Clause 1 to 53 were adopted.

The Title of the Bill was adopted.

Then, the proposal "Bill be passed" was moved by Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was passed by the House.

C. "Atal Bihari Vajpayee Skill University, Tripura Bill, 2025 (The Tripura Bill No. 10 of 2025)"

Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-Charge of the Higher Education Department moved for Leave of the House to introduce the Bill.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was introduced.

Thereafter, the following Hon'ble Members took part in the discussion.

ii) Shri Sudip Roy Barman, Hon'ble Member demand that the Bill to be send to the Select Committee.

Shri Kishor Barman and Shri Ratan Lal Nath, Hon'ble Ministers replied to the debate and rejected the demand.

Then all opposition Members walk-out from the House. The Motion for Consideration of the Bill was moved by Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department.

The Motion for Consideration was adopted and clause by clause Consideration of the Bill was taken up.

The Clause 1 to 53 were adopted.

The Title of the Bill was adopted.

Then, the proposal "Bill be passed" was moved by Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was passed by the House.

D. "International University, Tripura Bill, 2015 (The Tripura Bill No. 13 of 2025)."

Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department moved for leave of the House to introduce the Bill.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was introduced.

The Motion for Consideration was adopted and clause by Clause of the Bill was taken up.

The Clause 1 to 53 were adopted.

The Title of The Bill was adopted

Then, The proposal "Bill be passed" was moved by Shri Kishor Barman, Hon'ble Minister-in-charge of the Higher Education Department.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was passed by the House.

E. "Tripura Tenancy Bill, 2025 (The Tripura Bill No.6 of 2026)."

Professor (Dr.) Manik Saha, Hon'ble Chief Minister moved for Leave of the House to introduce the Bill.

The Motion was put to voice vote and the Bill was introduced.

The Motion for Consideration was adopted and clause by Clause of the Bill was taken up.

The Clause 1 to 47 were adopted.

The schedule of the Bill was adopted.

The Title of the Bill was also adopted.

Then, the proposal "Bill be passed" was moved by Professor (Dr.) Manik Saha, Hon'ble Chief Minister.

Motion was put to voice vote and the bill was passed by the House.
